2. PAYMENT

The fee for attending the workshop is as stated on the booking form. All payments for the booking fee must be made in full at the time of completing the booking prior to the date of the Workshop. Reservations will not be confirmed unless payment is made.

3. REFUNDS

All tickets for the Workshop shall be non-refundable except as set out in paragraphs 5 and 6 below. All persons who have booked and subsequently cancel or fail to attend shall forfeit all fees and charges paid. The IFA reserves the right to reallocate such tickets.

4. TRANSFER

5. CANCELLATION

The IFA reserve the right to cancel a course at short notice should events beyond our control make this unavoidable. If this should occur, participants will be offered a place on the next available scheduled course, or alternative dates.
